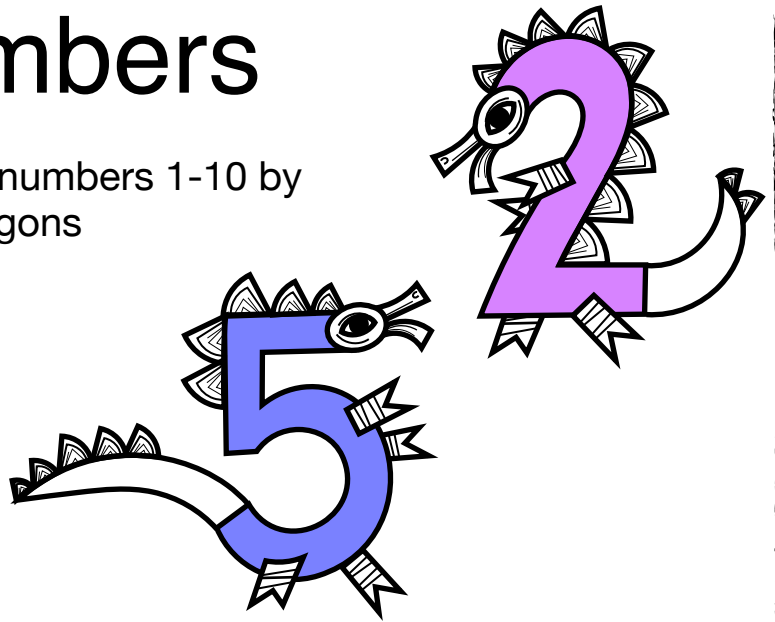


Dragon Numbers

Goal: To become familiar with numbers 1-10 by transforming numbers into dragons

You might use:

- Paper, construction paper, crayons, markers, pencils, scissors, modeling clay, glue, sandpaper, glitter, felt, foam



What to do:

- Select the number that you will transform into a dragon.
- Create the number with the materials you want to use.
- Add the dragon's face, tail, feet, scales, and other features. Is your dragon breathing fire?
- Select another number to transform into a dragon.
- If you like, create a scene or story with your dragon numbers.

Other Ways to Play:

- Roll a dice or a pair of dice to determine which number you will transform into a dragon.
- Make a dragon number line with the multiples of two (2, 4, 6, 8, 10) or the multiples of three (3, 6, 9, 12).
- Make dragon numbers with recycled materials, like cardboard tubes, packing materials, and cereal boxes.
- Make your address number or phone number with dragon numbers.
- Select a number that is not familiar to your child. Transform the number into a dragon. Create other objects that correspond with the value of the number to add to your dragon creation.
