

Under, below, beside...

This is a game for two or more people. At least one must be a reader.

Goal: Use positional words to place an action figure in relationship to transparent cups

You will need:

- A stack of position word cards
- Three transparent plastic cups
- A small action figure(s)

How to play:

1. The older player goes first.
2. Draw a card and read the word on the card.
3. Use the word to place the action figure in relationship to the cups.
4. Alternate turns.
5. Game ends when all of the cards have been drawn and played. To continue playing shuffle the cards and play another round.

To Think About: Is there more than one way to place the action figure for each word?
