

Finish A Face

Goal: Explore symmetry.

You will need:

- A piece of paper
- An image of half a face, could be a photo that is cut in half or one of the Early Math Project face line drawings
- Paper
- Pencil, Pen, Crayons, or Markers

What to do:

- Place the half-face image in the middle of a sheet of paper so there is enough room to draw a complete face.
- Consider where each facial feature should be drawn, its size, and its shape so your drawing is a mirror image of the half-face you are duplicating.
- Make sure that every feature of the face is present in your drawing.
- Once you are done, you might enjoy creating other symmetrical images from half a picture.
- Notice that many faces are not symmetrical and if you make a mirror image with both halves of your face, you may find that the images don't look particularly alike.
