



Symmetry with halves Start with a rectangular piece of paper Fold in half












Rectangle Fold Cut Open












With 12 sections





Symmetry with 12 sections Fold the square in half Fold it in half again















Roll the corners inward as if making a cone Flatten the cone when the edges align


















