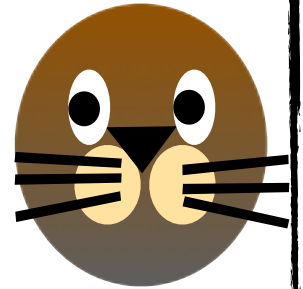


Shapely Sea Creatures

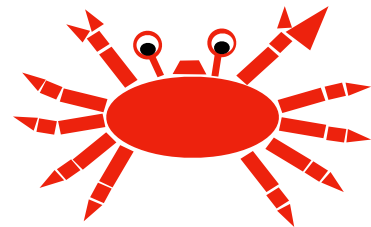
This is an activity for one or more people.

Goal: To create sea creatures or a sea creature collage using different shapes



You might use:

- Construction paper, recycled magazines, newspaper
- Scissors
- Tape or glue
- Pencils, crayons, or markers



What to do:

- Decide what type of sea creature(s) you will make.
- Consider which shapes you will use to create the sea creature(s).
- Cut these shapes from paper and arrange them on another piece of paper.
- Glue or tape the shapes onto a piece of paper.
- Show your artwork to another person and tell them about the shapes you used in your design.

Other things to try:

- Make a shape collage of your favorite animal or place.
- Make a shape collage using only one shape.
- Make a city collage using three dimensional shapes.
- Cut out squares, rectangles, circles, and triangles. With a partner create a collage of dog, but don't glue it down. Then take turns either adding, removing, or moving shapes to turn the dog into a different animal. Take turns changing the animal and guessing what type of new animal has been created.
